Barbara Larson née Sayers (1920-2016)

It is with regret that we must inform you of the passing of Barbara Larson who died peacefully in her sleep on Friday, June 17th.

Barbara Larson née Sayers was one of the original donors of Benares Historic House along with her siblings, Dora Caro and Geoffrey Sayers. She was a strong supporter of the Museums serving on the Benares Advisory Committee as well as being a life-time member of the Friends of the Museums of Mississauga.

Barbara was in her 96th year and died at her home in Kelowna, B.C. surrounded by her family after a short illness. The Museums of Mississauga will host a celebration of life for Barbara on September 11 (10:30 AM to 12:00 PM) at the family's request, at Benares Historic House. The celebration will include members of the Friends of the Museums, MOMAC, and Museums staff. Light refreshments will be served. A book of remembrance will be provided to guests and the public, until 4:00 PM.

This white cedar log house was built by Robert Leslie in 1826 on Mississauga Road, north of Derry. In 1994 it was moved to its current location at 4415 Mississauga Road North (near Hwy 403). The building is designated under the Ontario Heritage Act.

Since 2011, Streetsville Historical Society volunteers have ensured that the house is open to the public on Wednesday and Sunday, 1:00 to 4:00 PM weekly.

Tonight, look up to see what's hiding in the trees - the next scream you hear could be your own! The Birds was released in 1963 and was Hitchcock's 49th film. When audiences left the film's UK premiere at the Odeon, Leicester Square, London, they were greeted by the sound of screeching and flapping birds from loudspeakers hidden in the trees to scare them further.

A wealthy San Francisco socialite pursues a potential boyfriend to a small Northern California town that slowly takes a turn for the bizarre when birds of all kinds suddenly begin to unexplainably attack people. Soon, birds in the hundreds and thousands are attacking anyone they find out of doors. There is no explanation as to why this might be happening, and as the birds continue their vicious attacks, survival becomes the priority.
